The Kent City Student Government will sponsor a scholarship to a graduating senior. The scholarship will provide a minimum of \$250.00 and a maximum of \$500.00 to the student who has given the most significant citizen/service to the school and/or community during their high school years.

Students who are active participants in Student Government may apply. Significant criteria for consideration are exemplary performance in the areas of service, citizenship, commitment, and accountability. Ideally, students should have contributed 100 hours of service over the past year. Students applying should be planning on attending college, trade school, or service academies following graduation.

Applications must be submitted by the deadline established for local scholarships by the high school office and the principal, generally just prior to Spring Break each year. The deadline will be posted in the daily announcements.
