For the 2021-22 school year, schools were identified using definitions and labels as required in the Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA). A Targeted Support and Improvement (TSI) school is one that has at least one underperforming student subgroup. An Additional Targeted Support (ATS) school is one that has a student subgroup performing at the same level as the lowest 5% of all schools in the state. A Comprehensive Support and Improvement (CSI) school is one whose performance is in the lowest 5% of all schools in the state or has a graduation rate at or below 67%. Some schools are not identified with any of these labels. In these cases, no label is given.

Our school has not been given one of these labels.

Although Kent City High School was not given a support label, we continue to work toward closing the achievement gap for our students. At KCHS, we are committed to improving instructional outcomes for every student and teaching the "whole child" by maintaining a focus on social and emotional health.

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Concurrent Enrollment with GRCC

Students at KCHS can earn a total of 30 credits from Grand Rapids Community College by the time that they graduate by taking classes that are offered on the KCHS campus. This has taken the place of Advance Placement (AP) offerings at KCHS. During the 20 - 21 school year, 33/77 (43%) of seniors took advantage of this opportunity. During the 21 - 22 school year that value was 41/78 (53%). The concurrent enrollment opportunities were extended in 20 - 21 to now offer GRCC classes to KCHS juniors, as well.

The purpose of this report is to inform the community as to the status of their schools. The report summarizes the information into the mandated areas. As indicated by the information above, KCHS continues to provide a top tier education for all students. This is achieved through the hard work and dedication of our staff and students, the level of involvement by parents, and the support that the community provides to the schools. Nos complace presentarle el Informe Anual de Educación (AER) que proporciona información clave sobre el progreso educativo 2021-22 para Kent City High School. Para el año escolar 2021-22, las escuelas se identificaron utilizando definiciones y etiquetas como se requiere en la Ley Cada Estudiante Triunfa (ESSA). Una escuela de Apoyo y Mejora Dirigida (TSI) es aquella que tiene al menos un subgrupo de estudiantes de bajo rendimiento. Una escuela de Apoyo Específico Adicional (ATS) es aquella que tiene un subgrupo de estudiantes que se desempeña al mismo nivel que el 5% más bajo de todas las escuelas en el estado. Una escuela de Apoyo y Mejora Integral (CSI) es aquella cuyo desempeño está en el 5% más bajo de todas las escuelas en el estado o tiene una tasa de graduación igual o inferior al 67%. Algunas escuelas no están identificadas con ninguna de estas etiquetas. En estos casos, no se da ninguna etiqueta.

Nuestra escuela no ha recibido una de estas etiquetas.

Aunque Kent City High School no recibió una etiqueta de apoyo, continuamos trabajando para cerrar la brecha de rendimiento para nuestros estudiantes. En KCHS, estamos comprometidos a mejorar los resultados de instrucción para cada estudiante y enseñar al "niño completo" manteniendo un enfoque en la salud social y emocional.
