## Attendance Matters at KCHS

Consistent attendance is one of the most important factors in a student's success. When students are present and on time each day, they're more connected to their learning, their teachers, and their classmates.

Of course, we want students to stay home when they're sick—but otherwise, being here every day truly matters.

Students who miss 10% or more of the school year (about 18 days) are considered **chronically absent**, and research shows that chronic absenteeism can lead to lower grades, increased stress, and fewer opportunities after high school.

During WIN, students have been setting personal attendance goals, and we appreciate the partnership of our families in helping them reach those goals.

## Michigan Achievement Scholarship

All Michigan high school seniors can earn a certificate or associate's degree tuition-free at their local community college, earn up to \$27,500 at Michigan public or private university or earn up to \$4,000 at a career training program. Students become eligible by simply completing the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA).
