 - o "Click to edit..." on the right side of the screen
 - After selecting six courses, 12 semester courses, click "Submit" in the bottom left part of the screen.
- Remember, you must pick enough courses to fill six hours, unless you are a senior taking two or more GRCC courses. Those seniors are allowed one open hour
